- Heavy reduction in admission of students to the architectural schools due to former high unemployment
- Risk of lack of architects in the future

What we expect from the European Institutions (and/or ACE)

- The revision of EPBD was well done
- EU must do more to push all aspects of the UN goals of sustainability
- Only general regulations that are more helpful than harmful to the free movement of architectural services. Bad examples are service passport and insurance harmonisation, which harms more than they help
- Big need for reducing transaction costs in competitions
