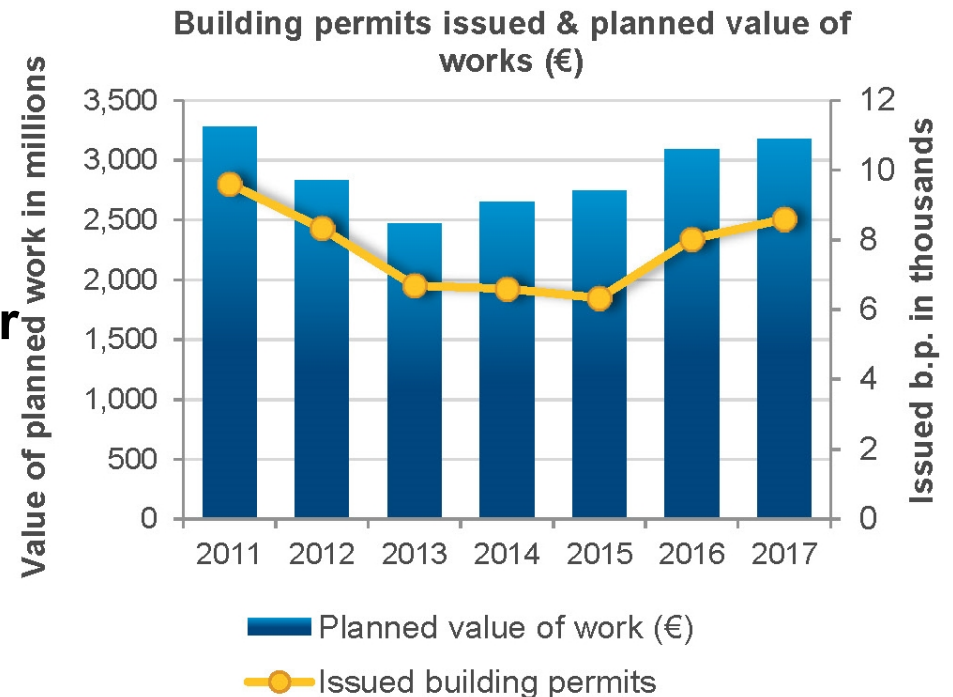

Building permitting and spatial planning requirements

- national level abstractions vs. local level implementation
