



A NEW ARCHITECTURE

ELIZABETH DE PORTZAMPARC

- Three experimental workshop since 1970's, including the sustainable workshop, created in 2008. Transdisciplinary, they have oriented the development of projects.
- The criticism or the Modern Movement while retaining its relevant contributions, leads to the development of 10 principles, which are called the New Architecture.
- Principles conceived as orientations to obtain more virtuous and sustainable projects. These can be applied in all cultures as themes and not predefined standards or aesthetics.





SCIENCE HALL – ZHANGJIANG SCIENCE CITY (2017-2022)

ELIZABETH DE PORTZAMPARC

- Vertical village for the regeneration of neighborhood life, through this public facility open to the city
- A rooftop park of almost 2ha and a public square on the ground of 1ha







SCIENCE HALL – ZHANGJIANG SCIENCE CITY (2017-2022)

ELIZABETH DE PORTZAMPARC

- "Modern classic" construction methods, metal and concrete beams and metal square beams suspended for the cantilever
- Sustainable ceramic, photovoltaic electricity production, storage robot for unforeseen events
